

Booking Form

Pre-booking for the walks, transport and evening events is essential. The number of places available is limited and anyone who has not booked is unlikely to be able to secure a place. Booking information is used to organise catering and transport arrangements.

Please enter the number of walkers in the box alongside each walk, and the number of tickets required in the box beside the evening events. Please also enter the number of seats you require for transport. Payment for walks and evening events is required when booking. All cheques should be made payable to 'VisitScotland'.

Please also enter contact details of all walkers in your party on the reverse of the booking form, so that we can also let them know about next year's Walking Festival.

There is a small charge of £10 per person for each guided walk, which includes return transport from the Event Centre. The charge for evening events is £10 per person per event and will also include return transport to the Event Centre, where necessary. The All Abilities walk is discounted at £5 but you will need your own transport.
